
LETTER FROM THE LEADERSHIP TEAM

Impact Hub Berlin is a community, incubator, accelerator, coworking and event space with impact at its core. In short, we're the Berlin hub for companies and organisations that make the world a better place.

Our world desperately needs solutions that can scale, fast. Nature



and communities worldwide suffer from the accelerating effects of climate change and rapidly growing inequalities. Simultaneously an increasing number of entrepreneurs are striving to make a positive impact on people and the planet. Our business is to support their journey to success, and make sure their solutions scale at least as fast as our collective challenges.



SUCESS STORY

Skonelabs

Meet Skonelabs, the startup which developed a smart IoT device monitoring the quality of unpacked fresh foods and predicting spoilage, tackling one of the linear economy's most urgent problems food waste. Skonelabs's smart IoT device monitors the quality of the food & predicts spoilage when installed near unpacked food.

2023 was a thriving year for Skonelabs. The startup participated in two Impact Hub Berlin programmes in 2023: an incubator and an accelerator. After graduating in Circular Together in May, the Skonelabs team was accepted to the Impact Accelerator food waste track. Later in the year,

Skonelab founders Nishit Agarwal and Siddardha Koneti became part of the nawi.Berlin, a project funded by the Berlin Senate which offers affordable office space and community membership at Impact Hub Berlin. Still in 2023, Skonelabs raised a seed round of €150k from Antler.



SUCESS STORY

Rrreefs

Climate change, pollution, and overfishing have killed about half the coral worldwide, leading to a loss of the underlying complex reef structure. Female-founded Rrreefs came about in 2020 to tackle this problem by rebuilding degraded coral reefs with sustainable materials using pioneer technologies.

As part of Circular Together's first batch in 2021, **Impact Hub Berlin** supported Rrreefs with market analysis, customer research and a project plan to seek funding and partnership. The startup also took part in our Social Economy Berlin project, receiving coaching in community building in 2021 Their remarkable trajectory speaks

for itself. **Rrreefs has active pro**jects in the San Andres, Pujada **Bay and Cooper Islands**. They have spoken in prestigious stages like Bits & Pretzels, ChangeNOW and NOAH Conference, won the PlanetHero award, got featured on National Geographic and raised € 420.000 in their first investment round from investors.






FLAGSHIP CONFERENCE





THE HOUSE OF IMPACT

3500m²

Our coworking space is the physical representation of Impact Hub Berlin's values, with community at its heart.

We need to add that this heart beats in an extraordinary body: a 3500m² space in the historic Kindle brewery area in trendy and innovative Berlin-Neukölln.

An award-winning, international lighthouse project of circular architecture, the Impact Hub Berlin building is unique to Europe in its design and history.

Circularly built and run

Our space is the manifestation of circular construction principles such as reuse and flexibility of components, recycling materials and facilitating future usage and maintenance. Approximately 70% of the materials and products used in construction and interior design are repurposed, recycled or natural. From repurposed windows, ventilation pipes or parts from museum exhibitions to lots of wood and hemp, the design principle of "form follows availability" led to unique aesthetics and a reduced environmental impact.





Electricity

Externally supplied electricity via Original Energie Ökostrom a combined heat and power plant operated by Berliner Stadtwerke, which can be operated with climate gas in the future, and, if necessary, battery storage.



Energy Neighbourhood

The building is embedded in an energy concept coupled with the neighbouring building. Heat pumps with long-term and short-term storage units ensure a sustainable heat supply based on as much renewable energy as possible.



Smart Energy

The areas of the Impact Hub Berlin are heated/cooled in a combination of conventional radiators and a ventilation system with heat recovery. The upper floors work with ceiling heating panels. The radiators are controlled by a Smart Heating System from Vilisto.



Heated Water

Water is heated with a modern and efficient Solar Thermal System.

THE HOUSE OF IMPACT

Drawing Circles

There is a German metaphor to describe something that has a significant impact on its surroundings. Taken from the effect of a stone dropped in a body of water, we say that things draw circles - Kreise ziehen.

In 2023 our circular coworking space has been drawing impressive circles, small and large, in the media and public sphere. From awards and nominations to over 20 media mentions and our participation in the 18th International

Architecture Exhibition of La Biennale di Venezia, with a total of 285,000 tickets sold, the second most highly attended Biennale Architettura in its history — our space gaining recognition and making us proud.
